As soon as signups are completed, we will distribute a final schedule and show-day instructions. Be sure to invite parents, grandparents and friends to this fun event!

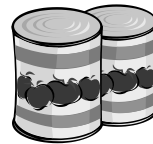
HALLOWEEN ABSENCES
